5. What is the mode of examination?

Mode of Examination will be online (Remote Proctored Online Mode). The student can write the exam from home. The student can attempt the test with desktop or laptop. The student cannot write the exam using Mobile Phone. The test will be AI monitored, as well as proctors and super proctors will be present. The detailed instructions regarding system configuration, Internet speed will be mailed to the students and will be available in the website one week before the exam.

6. How many slots will be available per day during the exam dates?

There will be one slot per day during the exam dates. When the slot booking is open (tentatively 3 days before the start of exam), the student can book the slot based on their convenience. Once the slot is booked, the student can download the Hall Ticket

7. Are there any mock tests conducted?

Yes, there will be a mock test conducted before the main exam. Mock Test can be taken by the students at their convenience.

8. How to edit the application form?

Kindly post your query under form correction category for any correction.

9. I have done the payment for application but in portal, status is pending?

Kindly wait for 24 hours or you can post your query under technical query category.

10. What is the mode of payment for application?

Online payment (Debit card, Credit card, UPI, Net banking).

11. What are the documents to be uploaded in the application?

Photo Image, Signature Image

12. Is the application fee refundable?

Application fee is Non- Refundable.

13. How is the admission process carried out for the programs in the Faculty of Medicine & Allied Health Sciences?

Admissions for the programs are conducted through a comprehensive scrutiny of the candidate's academic credentials (Entrance Exam + E-counselling+ Interview).

16. What is the last date to submit the application form?

SRMJEEH PG 2025 - Phase I:

Last date for applications- 07.04.2025.

SRMJEEH PG 2025 - Phase II:

Last date for applications- 08.06.2025.

SRMJEEH POST PG 2025:

Last date for applications- 07.04.2025.

17. Is the tuition fee refundable?

Yes, the fees will be refunded as per the norms set by UGC. Please refer to UGC website from time to time.

18. What is Provisional Allotment Letter?

Upon payment of the registration fee and counselling fee, a Provisional allotment letter and fee receipt will be issued. The Program allotment will be published in the Online Admission Portal (OAP). This Provisional Allotment Letter is accepted by various banks/financial institutions for processing of educational loans if required.

19. Will the SRMJEEH PG & POST PG result be available online?

Yes, the SRMJEEH PG & POST PG result will be available online. Once the exam is conducted and the results are declared, candidates can check their individual scores on the Admission Portal.

20. Is it compulsory for candidates to appear for all phases of SRMJEEH PG and POST PG?

No, it is not mandatory for candidates to appear in all phases of SRMJEEH PG and POST PG. However, you can choose to apply for either Phase 1, Phase 2 for SRMJEEH PG and SRMJEEH POST PG will have one Phase, all based on your preference.

21. Is there any negative marking in SRMJEEH PG and POST PG?

No, there **is no negative marking** in SRMJEEH PG and POST PG

22. Do I need to be an expert in computer operations to take the SRMJEEH PG & POST PG online exam?

No, you do not need to be an expert in computer operations to take the SRMJEEH PG & POST PG online exam. The exam is designed to be user-friendly, and basic computer skills such as using a mouse, keyboard, and navigating through multiple-choice questions are sufficient.

However, it is recommended to familiarize yourself with the online exam interface before the test. SRM provides a mock test or a practice session before the actual exam to help you get comfortable with the format and navigation of the online test.

23. What are the system requirements for SRMJEEH PG & POST PG online exam?

For the SRMJEEH PG & POST PG online exam, you will need:

- a. A **desktop or laptop** with a functional **webcam**.
- b. **Google Chrome** or **Mozilla Firefox** browser installed.
- c. A stable **internet connection** with a minimum speed of 2 Mbps.
- d. A **microphone** (if needed for verification) and **headphones** for better sound quality.
