The application fee is Rs.1200 for each phase of SRMJEEH UG

5. Is it mandatory to pass the NEET exam to gain admission to all Health Science programs?

No, it is not mandatory to pass the NEET exam. However, appearing for the NEET exam is compulsory for admission to **BOT, BPT, and all Allied Health Sciences programs**. Candidates **who do not appear** for NEET will not be eligible for admission to SRMIST.

6. Is NEET mandatory along with the SRMJEEH exam for all Health Science programs?

Yes, it is mandatory to **appear for the NEET exam** even if you have appeared for the **SRMJEEH exam**. Candidates who do not appear for NEET will not be eligible for admission to BOT, BPT and all Allied Health Sciences programs.

7. Is it mandatory to appear for the NEET exam in the current year, or is a previous year's NEET score acceptable?

Candidates must **appear for the NEET exam in the current year (2026)**. NEET scores from previous years are **not acceptable** for admission to BOT, BPT and all Allied Health Sciences programs.

8. What is the mode of examination?

The mode of Examination will be online (Remote Proctored Online Mode). The student can write the exam from home. The student can attempt the test on a desktop or laptop. The student cannot write the exam using a Mobile Phone. The test will be AI-monitored, and proctors and super proctors will be present. The detailed instructions regarding system configuration and Internet speed will be mailed to the students and will be available on the website one week before the exam.

9. How many slots will be available per day during the exam dates?

There will be one slot per day during the exam dates. When the slot booking is open (tentatively 3 days before the start of the exam), the student can book the slot based on their convenience. Once the slot is booked, the student can download the Hall Ticket.

10. Are there any mock tests conducted?

Yes, there will be a mock test conducted before the main exam. Mock Test can be taken by the students at their convenience.

12. How to edit the application form?

Kindly post your query under the form correction category for any corrections.

13. I have made the payment for the application, but on the portal, the status is pending.

Kindly wait for 24 hours, or you can post your query under the technical query category.

14. What is the mode of payment for the application?

Online payment (Debit card, Credit card, UPI, Net banking).

15. What are the documents to be uploaded to the application?

Photo Image, Signature Image

16. Is the application fee Refundable?

The application fee is non-refundable.

17. How to edit the course preference in the application form, which has already been submitted?

Course/Campus preference selected at the time of application is only for statistical purposes; the actual course preference can be selected at the time of choice filling based on SRMJEEH UG – Rank and availability of seats.

18. What is the fee structure and eligibility for various courses?

19. Whether I need to submit a separate application for each phase?

Yes, Students are required to submit a separate application for each phase.

20. What is the last date to submit the application form?

SRMJEEH UG 2026 - Phase I:

Last date for applications- 11.04.2026

SRMJEEH UG 2026 - Phase II:

Last date for applications- 30.05.2026

21. Will the SRMJEEH UG exams for each phase be held separately?

The SRMJEEH UG exam will be held in online mode for each phase separately. Once the candidate has qualified through the SRMJEEH UG, the candidate will be required to select the campus and program of their choice in SRM's admission portal.

22. What happens after the SRMJEEH UG Exams?

The results of the SRMJEEH UG will be announced. After the results, candidates are required to participate in the program choice filling process. The detailed admissions process is given below.



23. Is the tuition fee refundable?

Yes, the fees will be refunded as per the norms set by UGC. Please refer to the UGC website from time to time.

24. What is the Provisional Allotment Letter?

Upon payment of the registration fee and counselling fee, a Provisional allotment letter and fee receipt will be issued. The Program allotment will be published in the Online Admission Portal (OAP). This Provisional Allotment Letter is accepted by various banks/financial institutions for the processing of educational loans if required.

25. Will the SRMJEEH UG result be available online?

Yes, the SRMJEEH UG result will be available online. Once the exam is conducted and the results are declared, candidates can check their individual scores on the Admission Portal.

26. Is it compulsory for candidates to appear for all phases of SRMJEEH UG?

No, it is not mandatory for candidates to appear in all phases of SRMJEEH UG. However, you can choose to apply for either Phase 1, Phase 2 or all based on your preference.

27. Is there any negative marking in SRMJEEH UG?

No, there **is no negative marking** in SRMJEEH UG.

28. Do I need to be an expert in computer operations to take the SRMJEEH UG online exam?

No, you do not need to be an expert in computer operations to take the SRMJEEH UG online exam. The exam is designed to be user-friendly, and basic computer skills, such as using a mouse, keyboard, and navigating through multiple-choice questions, are sufficient.

However, it is recommended to familiarise yourself with the online exam interface before the test. SRM provides a mock test or a practice session before the actual exam to help you get comfortable with the format and navigation of the online test.

29. What are the system requirements for the SRMJEEH UG online exam?

For the SRMJEEH UG online exam, you will need:

- a. A **desktop or laptop** with a functional **webcam**.
- b. **Google Chrome** or **Mozilla Firefox** browser installed.
- c. A stable **internet connection** with a minimum speed of 2 Mbps.
- d. A **microphone** (if needed for verification) and **headphones** for better sound quality.
