FAQs PGDM Admission 2025

Q1. What are the eligibility criteria to apply for the PGDM program at the Institute?

- 1. Hold a **Bachelor's Degree** with the minimum percentage required as per **AICTE guidelines**. Final-year students may apply but must be graduate before securing admission.
- 2. Have appeared for at least one of the following entrance exams:
 - o CAT (2024)
 - o XAT (2025)
 - o GMAT (2023 onwards)
 - o CMAT (2025)
 - o MH-CET (2025)
 - o MAT (2025/2024)
 - o ATMA (2025/2024)

Q2. How can I apply for this program?

The application for PGDM (Batch 2025-27) is online. Applicants can apply online on: https://apply.nldalmia.in/pgdm-application-form.

Q3. Is the PGDM program equivalent to MBA?

Yes, all the PGDM programs are equivalent to MBA.

Q4. How will the CTR & PI process be conducted?

The CTR & PI process will be conducted Face-to-Face or Online.

Q5. What is the Critical Thinking Round (CTR)? Is it the same as Group Discussion (GD)?

The "Critical Thinking round" in an MBA interview is similar to a Group Discussion (GD), but instead of debating in a group, you are given a topic or a situation and need to individually share your knowledge, insights, and logical perspective about it.

Q6. What are the various PGDM programs at N.L. Dalmia, along with the no. of seats?

We have the following 3 programs in PGDM at N. L. Dalmia:

- 1. PGDM (with specialization in Finance/Mktg/HR) = 360 seats
- 2. PGDM in Business Analytics = 60 seats
 - a. PGDM in Business Analytics (Core)
 - b. PGDM in Business Analytics (Specialization in Finance)
 - c. PGDM in Business Analytics (Specialization in Marketing)

Q7. What is the duration of this program?

All the PGDM programs are 2 years full-time program, comprising of 6 trimesters (3 trimesters per year).

Q8. Are the PGDM programs officially approved by AICTE?

Yes, all the PGDM programs are approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India

Q9. What are the accreditations of the Institute?

NLDIMSR is accredited with 'A+'by NAAC (2nd cycle), NBA and SAQS

Q10.Is the PGDM program AIU approved?

Yes, all the PGDM programs are approved by AIU.

Q11. What are the selection criteria on which I would be evaluated?

PGDM admission evaluation is holistic –and not based on test scores alone. The applicant would be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 1. Entrance Exam score (Any one of 7 aptitude tests accepted (CAT / XAT / CMAT / MH- CET / GMAT / MAT / ATMA). You can upload scores for more than one if available.
- 2. Personal Interview
- 3. Critical Thinking Round (CTR)
- 4. Past Academic Record (10th, 12th and Graduation)
- 5. Work Experience (if any)
- 6. Extra-Curricular Activity (Sports/Art) (District / State / National Level only)

Q12. What is the weightage of each selection criteria?

This is a general guide. (For applicants with exceptional achievements in one or other field, this could vary).

• Entrance Exam score	40%
• Personal Interview	20%
• Critical Thinking Round (CTR)	15%
• Past Academic Record (10 th ,12 th , Graduation/ Post Graduation)	15%
Work Experience	05%
• Extra-Curricular Activity (Sports/Art)	05%

Q13. What is the performance benchmark for the cut-off score in the aptitude entrance exam?

Entrance Exam Scores: The percentiles listed below reflect the typical performance benchmarks observed among admitted students in the previous batch (2024-26):

CAT: 91.73 | XAT: 90.81 | GMAT: 672 | CMAT: 94.29 | MH-CET: 95.54

(These are indicative and based on last year's admitted batch. Candidates with slightly lower scores but strong confidence in their Critical Thinking Ability (CTA) and Personal Interview (PI) performance are encouraged to apply.)

Good Academic Record: Strong past academic performance is a key factor.

Composite Score: Selection is based on a composite score that considers entrance exam performance, Critical Thinking (CT), Personal Interview (PI), Academic Records and Work Experience.

Q14. What is the application form fee?
