

## **BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT ELECTIVE FOCUS IN B.E. (CHEMICAL ENGINEERING)**

B.E. Chemical Engineering program is designed to offer elective focus (EF) after student clears semester VI (3<sup>rd</sup> year) of the program. Student has to choose EF out of the following four choices:

- Energy
- Materials
- Petroleum
- Chemical Process Engineering

The student will be given their choices based on after 2<sup>nd</sup> year CGPA. The choice of elective courses and the project work will be related to the EF chosen. Thus a student will graduate with a B.E. Chemical Engineering degree alongwith a EF certificate in the chosen area in Energy/Materials/Petroleum/Chemical Process Engineering.

The additional EF certificate will give an edge to the student in placements and career growth, and also better opportunities for pursuing higher studies in the EF area.
